## Sustainable Peri-Urban Landscapes

Development, visions and strategies



Peri-urban landscapes are characterised by great heterogeneity and rapid changes of land use, because they are attractive to many functions and permanently under pressure from urban expansion and demands imposed by nearby population concentrations. Ensuring the landscape quality of such areas requires innovative and strategic planning as well as collaboration among many stakeholders and citizens.

With the peri-urban areas of Copenhagen as playground experienced students within landscape architecture, countryside management, geography, as well as others with an interest in spatial planning are invited to participate in an international planning course for development of sustainable peri-urban landscapes.

The course takes point of departure in 'real life problems' of peri-urban areas of Copenhagen. Through collaboration and input from other students, teachers, planning professionals and citizens the students will get the opportunity to elaborate and practise their skills in planning, design and strategy making.

Through out the course the students will be provided with lectures, excursions etc. to support and inspire their practically work.

### **Time and venue:**

8 August – 20 August 2010

Application deadline is 1 May 2010

The course is held as a boarding school and accommodation and teaching will take place at a university location North of Copenhagen

Cost of Accommodation and living: 5000 ddk, which has to be paid in advance

The course gives a credit of 5 ECTS points.
