



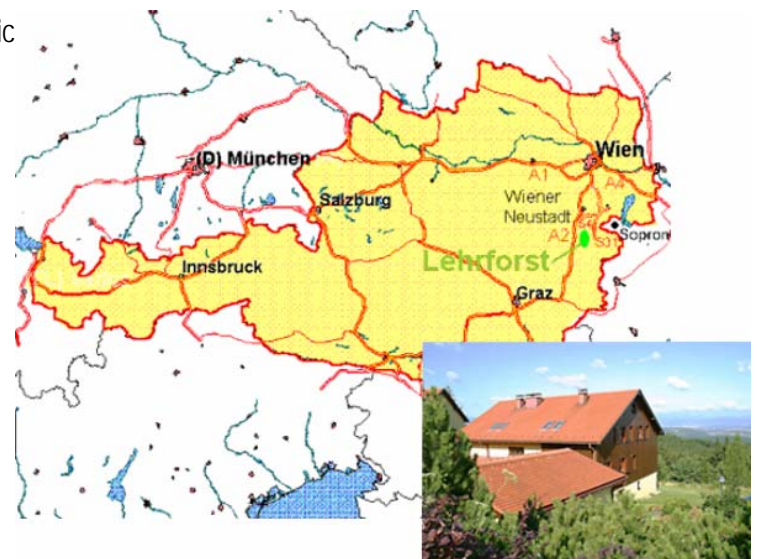
European Field Excursions in Environmental Science 2007 Integrated Watershed Management (EFEES 2007)

The 4th EFEES is held 29 July – 11 August 2007 hosted by University of Natural Resources and Applied Life Sciences Vienna (BOKU). One week of home studies followed by two weeks field excursion in Austria.

A general background in environmental science including insight in soil and water resources and management is recommended. The course is aimed at students finalising their BSc or starting up their MSc. Staff from BOKU and other ELLS universities and representatives from administration and enterprises will act as teachers and instructors.

Objectives

- to apply environmental science theories in a holistic way to problems observed in the field
- to get acquainted with environmental policies and local management strategies, European water framework directive and regulations
- to get insight into different types of pollution, environmental effects, remediation, environmental policies and local management strategies in different parts of Europe
- to learn tools for collecting, analysing, modelling and interpreting environmental data
- to experience the management of nature reserves in an agricultural landscape
- to draw on different expertises for problems solving in a group of students of different nationalities and with different backgrounds



EFEES (6 ECTS) is in English and includes:

- Pre-course video conference end of May 2007 for first contact and introduction
- One week home study, starting with videoconference 23 July 2007
- *Field excursion in Austria 29 July - 11 August 2007. Venue is Forchtenstein "Lehrforst"*

Application deadline is 31 March 2007

EFEES is for ca. 35 students in the end of B.Sc. / beginning of M.Sc.
